## FACILITIES EXTENDED

**LEARNING RESOURCE CENTRE :** A learning hub within the school being staffed by a librarian, an attendant, volumes of books and magazines from wide spectrums of wisdom, a state-of-the-art Reading-Room containing several information sources for extended reading and to facilitate education to both students and staff. In fact, it claims to be the second largest among its contemporaries in the state.

**DIGITAL LEARNING:** A full-fledged computer laboratory in a Wi-Fi school premises leaves its door wide open both on and off hours of school for extensive learning that is accompanied by instructional practices which makes effective use of technology. It encompasses the application of a wide spectrum of practices, including blended and virtual learning.

**AUDIO VISUAL ACCESSORIES:** The audio-visual class rooms being powered by TATA Edge Classes encourage the teaching learning process and make it easier, interesting and activity oriented. It leaves no compartment of mind unexercised and grasp to the brim.

**LABORATORIES :** Three well-equipped Basic Science Laboratories named Physics, Chemistry and Biology allow the students to interact directly with the data/ sample collected under the able supervision of highly qualified experienced teachers.

Students are made to use the models and understand different scientific theories and concepts.

**FITNESS, HEALTH AND WELLNESS :** School based programs are designed, formulated and inducted in the curriculum to increase potential among children to endure physical activity to a longer duration and enhance physical education as well. ## EXAMINATION & PROMOTION RULES

1. (a) Promotion is based on the day-to-day performance of the students throughout the year and also on the performance in the Periodic Tests, Half Yearly & Annual Examinations.  
(b) Seminar, Attendance, Sincerity, behavior will be assessed and graded.
2. HPER and Work Experience are important subjects. So detention, in these subjects will lead to total detention in the class.
3. Attendance in all the tests is compulsory. Any absence from the Test should be substantiated with valid reasons.
4. Students of Std-XI & XII should secure a minimum 33% marks, in each subject (in theory & practical separately) in the Half Yearly Examination and 75% attendance to be eligible for filling up forms for Board examination.
5. Result once declared by the Academic Committee shall be final and binding.
6. In order to get promotion to the next higher class:
  - a. A student has to secure 33% in theory of each subject and 33% in aggregate.
  - b. It is compulsory to appear at all the tests.
  - c. Minimum attendance required is 75%. This is in accordance with the CBSE Examination By-Laws.
  - d. Absent in any examination will result in 0 weightage.

## WITHDRAWAL RULES

1. Application for withdrawal is to be made in a prescribed preforma available in school office. No child can be withdrawn till a written request from parents is put up.
2. One month's notice period is required for withdrawal.



## THE CURRICULUM FOR LKG - IX

- The curriculum is rich with knowledge, skills and attitudes in the fullest sense. The school's concern with the pupil's self-development and his or her preparation for the demands of society is expressed through its curriculum.
- LKG : English, Arithmetic, Art and Craft, Conversation, Physical Activity.
- U.K.G. : English, Arithmetic, Art and Craft, Conversation, Hindi/Odia, Physical Activity.
- Std-I to IV : English, Hindi/ Odia, Mathematics, Environmental Studies, Art & Craft, G.K., Moral Education, Conversation, H.P.E.R.
- III & IV : Computer Science, Yoga & Dance.
- N.B. : Apart from English any one other language will be offered i.e. either Hindi or Odia.
- Std-V to VIII: English, Hindi, Odia, Mathematics, Environmental Studies, Science, Social Science, Moral Education, General Knowledge, Computer Science (Work Experience), Health and Physical Education, Art Education,(Music/Painting/dance) and Yoga.
- N.B. : Apart from English either Hindi or Odia is compulsory. Students who opt for Hindi as 2nd language have to take Odia as 3rd language and students who opt for Odia as 2nd language should take Hindi as 3rd language. The subject opted for 2nd language and Art Education is not alterable.
- Std-IX & X : English, Hindi / Odia / Sanskrit, Mathematics, Science, Social Science, Computer Science (Work Experience), Health and Physical Education, Art Education.
- N.B. : In addition to English only one language will be offered.

### SUBJECTS OFFERED

**Compulsory** : English (Core), General Studies, Work Experience &

**HPER Optional** : (1) Physics (2) Chemistry (3) Mathematics

**4th Elective** : Biology / Computer Science

## **GUIDELINES FOR REGISTRATION INTO LKG:**

- **1 REGISTRATION : (Disadvantaged group, Weaker Section)**
- (a) Registration Forms will be issued free of cost from the school office only to the Special Categories from the neighborhood of the school (residing within 1 Kilometer of the school) on submission of requisite documents.
- (b) Applicants other than the Special category can get the Registration Form on payment of **Rs. 1000/-** through Debit Card/Credit Card.
- (c) Registration Form duly filled in should be submitted along with the required documents and certificates as mentioned in the form, by the stipulated date. Filled in Registration form without supporting documents will not be entertained.
- (d) Children who are born between **01 April 2018 and 31st March 2019** (both days inclusive) for LKG are only eligible for registration to the **Academic Session 2023-24**.
- (e) Registration fee is not refundable.
- (f) Every year, we have more applicants than number of seats available. Therefore, if a candidate is unable to secure a seat, it is in no way a reflection of his/her calibre.

**N.B. :** (1) Any applicant desirous of availing admission under more than one of the above Categories/sub-categories shall submit separate Registration Form for each of the above categories to be considered there under. (2) There will be no interview or screening of children or their parents. Admission will be based on the information given and backed by authentic proofs with documents attached to the form at the time of submission. Information regarding parents' professions and educational qualifications will not form a part of the admission criteria. It will be used only for school data processing. The children will be admitted through Random Selection (Draw of lots). (3) Birth Certificate in Original from the Competent Authority is essential at the time of admission for verification. (4) Aadhaar No. is essential for admission. (5) Presence of parents (Father & Mother both) is essential at the time of admission. (6) The name of the child and the date of birth reflected in Birth Certificate will be entered in the school's admission register and will not be changed further.

## **GUIDELINES FOR REGISTRATION INTO CLASSES UKG TO IX**

### **GENERAL RULES :**

- 1. Application form for admission into the above classes will be open as per the availability of vacancy on payment of Rs. 1000/-**
- Prospectus and forms for admission can be obtained from the school office as per the availability of vacancy on payment (Debit/Credit Card Only) of **Rs. 1000/-** after notification for the purpose.
- There will be an interactive Session/Aptitude Test for students seeking admission into Class – UKG onwards.
- The name of the successful candidates will be displayed on the notice board/School website ([www.davppl.org](http://www.davppl.org)) on the dates intimated.
- Registration fee is not refundable, and registration does not guarantee admission.
- The photocopy of birth certificate issued by the competent authority is to be attached with the admission form for classes LKG, UKG and Std-I.
- For class-II and above students, must submit the Transfer Certificate issued from the previous school mentioning the CBSE affiliation number on it. The name of the school must be on the board's website as an affiliated school.
- In case of students transfer from a school recognized by/ affiliated to any other recognized Board (except CBSE) the School Leaving Certificate must be countersigned by the concerned State Education Authority.
- No student from disaffiliated or unrecognized schools can be allowed to take admission in this institution.
- Fees have to be deposited within the stipulated dates, failing which the seat will be allotted to the next waitlisted candidate.
- The name once entered on the School Rolls, the date of birth shown on the admission form, birth certificate or on the Transfer Certificate will not be altered as per the guidelines of the CBSE.

### **ADMISSION**

- Successful candidates whose names are included in the list must pay the fees by the dates indicated on the list, displayed on the school notice board otherwise admission will automatically stand cancelled.

## **GUIDELINES FOR REGISTRATION INTO CLASSES XI (OUTSIDE STUDENTS)**

**For Admission into Class XI in Science for outside students an Aptitude Test will be conducted**

1. The detailed of aptitude test will be informed well in time.
  2. The result of aptitude test will be published in the school notice board and selection of students for admission will be done strictly according to the performance in the aptitude test.
  3. a. After publication of the Result of Aptitude Test, counselling and provisional admission will be held in our school premises.  
b. The parents have to give an undertaking that the School Authorities can take any action against their ward in case of showing dismal performance in three consecutive tests conducted by the school meant for continuous & comprehensive evaluation.(either surprise test or terminal test or both).  
c. In order to ensure a better examination-oriented preparation, it is to be strictly followed that the students have a minimum of 90% attendance in theory and 90% attendance in practical. Parents along with their ward should give an undertaking to ensure this.
  4. On the date of provisional admission / counselling the following points are to be noted.
    - a. Presence of parents
    - b. The details of Admission fee (which will be notified at the time of publication of result)
    - c. Absence in counselling will lead to forfeiture of claim for admission.
  5. a. On the date of final admission the following documents are necessary after publication of Board Result.
    - b. Original TC / School Leaving Certificate of the previous school.
    - c. Original Conduct Certificate from the concerned institution last attended.
    - d. Original Migration Certificate from the concerned Board.
- N.B: In case of failure to take final admission the provisional admission shall stand cancelled automatically and no fee will be refunded.
